**Under this agreement for 2018
Cranbrook State School will receive**

\$234,390*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in reading to 100% for Year 3 students.
- Maintain Cranbrook State School's Reading Means Scale Score for Year 3 students to at or above the State School average.
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance in numeracy.
- Improve Cranbrook State School's Numeracy Means Scale Score for Year 3 & 5 students to at or above the State School average.
- Meet the C or better target of 85% within each grade for Maths.

Our initiatives include

- Engage teaching staff in Collaborative Inquiry Cycles and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: mathematics learning area and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential mathematical concepts (Cranbrook's Guaranteed Mathematics Curriculum) and skills in every classroom (Yumi Maths)
- Provide intensive reading support for students demonstrating learning gaps in reading from year P-3.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Engage a Support Teacher in Numeracy to implement the pedagogical approach for Cranbrook's Guaranteed Mathematics Curriculum	\$70 000
• Provide additional Teacher Aides for Tier 2 Reading support.	\$50 000
• Increase the current Intervention Teacher Aide allocation to support additional students in successful Reading programs currently being implemented.	\$44 390
• Engage a Support Teacher in Reading to implement the Cranbrook State School's Teaching and Learning Policy for Reading.	\$70 000
